IC School Council Meeting

Those in attendance were Fr. Mike, Fr. Paul, Jeff Mollenhoff, Brent Volesky, Carol Dagel, Pete Bauman and Angel Oltjenbruns. Ann Hanson attended as a guest.

Fr. Mike opened with a prayer.

Ray read the minutes from the Sept. 9th, 2014 meeting. Motion made to approve, seconded and passed.

Angel gave the Financial report and discussed the budget. The Financial Report will look differently in the future as a new bookkeeping system from the Diocese that will not be as detailed as the current system. The budget still is following along as expected. Fr. Mike talked about a problem that hasn't been addressed yet. Major repairs to the facilities wasn't directly addressed in the School Charter. The Barn Dance went well this year. It was down 22 tickets from last year, 132 sold this year. The profit was \$9,980.

The Principal Report was handed out by Mrs. Dagel and was also sent out previously. The future of the school was discussed. Where are we going to be when the new ^{5th & 6th grades school} junior high opens and what direction do we want to go in our school? Pete felt there are two major areas that should be addressed before making any decisions on the future. First, he felt an outsider should be brought in to do an assessment of what our strengths and our future goals should be. Second, parents need to become more involved in our decisions. Fr. Paul suggested we have a task force to see why people send their children to our school and what their intentions are as to sending their children here after the new junior high opens. Fr. Paul will call and ask all of the people that were suggested to make up the Task Force.

Angel reported the savings account for the school is currently at \$73,480.70.

Fr. Paul closed with a prayer.
