# Principals Report-Becca Briggs

- Went over the new hires over the summer as well as the increasing enrollment numbers. We currently have 228 students enrolled
- Strategic Plan-Went over where we are on current curriculum. The diocese is looking at the standards for social studies
- There has been a drastic increase in the number of volunteers with the new volunteer policy
- IC will have an accreditation review in January 2024
- Current server is 10 years old and having lots of computer and internet issues. After speaking with Dawn at the diocese, we were able to get the cost down and decided to order a new one.
- Employee Handbook changes-teachers will receive sub pay until they are fully certified, added a code of ethics promoting Catholicism, pay lanes were added in, no unnatural hair coloring or facial piercings, and will be signed by staff.
- Student Handbook Changes-a matrix for behavior has been added and no facial piercings
- KOT price will increase to \$3.50 for IC students and \$4.00 per hour for non-IC students
- COVID Policy- there will be no policy. Masking is allowed, but not required
- Working with the police department on further security updates
