Principals Report- Becca Briggs

- Reviewed test scores for math and English. IC performed well above the state average in all areas.
- Gala-had first meeting with some of the committee members. Talked about a few ways to involve the kids with the fundraiser, a possible video, auctioning student artwork, etc. They are currently deciding on entertainment.
- Architects did a walk thru at the school to assess any major concerns regarding possible future building improvements
- Security Update-front door is now on an automatic locking system in the morning to eliminate someone needing to be available to lock it after the students arrive. Cameras are being installed to cover all doors, parking lot and playground.
- NWEA Map Testing- received the amazing news that an anonymous donor is going to cover the cost of the testing for 3 years
- Catholic Schools Week- January 29th-February 4th. The donor that normally covers the cost of tshirts for the entire diocese, is not able to this year. Looking for donors to cover the cost for the IC students. Would be about \$5 per tshirt, depending on if the diocese wants anything printed on the back.

- A survey will be going out the parents to get thoughts on the start and end date of the school term and uniforms
- Dinner Theater- January 27th and 28th. Cast is being assembled.
